## **ELIGIBILITY**

- Open to U.S.-based artists 18 years of age or older.
  - Only original abstract artwork will be considered.
  - Work must be non-representational or abstract in nature.
  - Artists may submit both 2D and 3D abstract work.

## ENTRY TERMS & CONDITIONS

- All artwork must be for sale.
  - Commission pieces are not permitted.
  - The artist must hold sole ownership of submitted artwork.
  - Juror decisions are final.
  - By submitting payment, artists agree to all terms outlined in this Prospectus.
  - Abstracts in America and ARTnNCEvents reserve the right to use images of artwork and event photography for promotional and marketing purposes.
  - Photography may occur during the exhibition.

# SALES & COMMISSION

- Artists are committed to the sale price submitted upon registration.
  - A 35% commission will be retained on all sales.
  - Sales tax will be handled and remitted by ARTnNCEvents & Bradley Carter Art LLC.
  - If artwork sells within two weeks after the exhibition as a result of exposure at the show, a 35% commission remains due.
  - If a registered piece sells prior to the show start date, it must hang as SOLD and remains subject to commission.

## GENERAL ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

- Artwork must be original in conception and execution.
  - No kits, copies, collaborative works, or workshop pieces.
  - No giclees, prints, or reproductions.
  - Artwork must be professionally presented.
  - No erotic or violent themes.
  - Work must be durable and safely displayable.
  - Artwork requiring individual easels will not be accepted.

## 2D ABSTRACT ART REQUIREMENTS

Maximum Submitted Pieces: 2

Accepted Mediums Include:

Acrylic, Oil, Mixed Media, Encaustic, Alcohol Ink, Drawing, Digital Abstract Art, Textile, Metal, Printmaking (original only), and Abstract Photography (limited edition series only).

No reproductions or giclees.

Size Limits (Unframed):

Maximum 48" wide x 48" high.

Size Limits (Framed):

Maximum 50" wide x 50" high.

Diptych/Triptych:

Must be connected and not exceed 50" overall size limit.

**Weight:**

Maximum 15 lbs including frame.

**Glass:**

Any piece over 30" requiring glass must use plexiglass.

**Presentation:**

- Professionally framed OR 1.5" gallery wrapped canvas or cradle.
- Mats must be white, black, off-white, or neutral.
- Wire hanging only. No sawtooth hangers.
- Wire must allow slack for Pro-Panel hanging systems.

## **3D ABSTRACT ART REQUIREMENTS**

Maximum Submitted Pieces: 2

**Accepted Mediums:**

Ceramic, Glass, Metal, Wood, Textile, Mixed Media, Jewelry, and other abstract sculptural work.

**Size Limits:**

Must fit on pedestal and not exceed 18" diameter.

Floor sculptures up to 5 feet considered if stable.

Maximum weight: 30 lbs.

**Requirements:**

Must be stable and not top-heavy.

No electrical or illuminated pieces.

No suspended installations.

Separate components must be secured and labeled.

**Labeling:**

Label affixed to bottom including:

Artist Name

Title

Medium

Price

## **INSTALLATION**

- Artists may not install or move artwork.
  - The Abstracts in America team will professionally install all accepted work.
  - Work not meeting requirements may be refused at check-in.
  - ARTnNCEvents cannot be held liable for damage or loss.

**Accepted Abstracts in America artists only.**

Space is limited.

A registration lottery will open:

**September 14, 2026 at 10:00 AM**

The first **50 accepted artists** to register will secure a space.

Participation Fee: **\$10 per artist**

Registration will be available via a separate JotForm link  
emailed to accepted artists.

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- The Artist Print & Small Works Market is **not part of judging**.
  - Maximum of **10 pieces per artist**.
  - **NO framed artwork permitted**.
- Original artwork and reproductions (prints) are allowed.
  - Bins must be provided by the artist.
- Artist's name must be affixed to the bottom of the bin.
  - Required bin specifications:
    - 42-inch height (when closed) - 24-inch width
    - Black canvas print rack with black legs **ONLY**.
      - No other sizes or bin types permitted.
- Abstracts in America will provide standard artist identification signage.
- Up to 50 standard-size business cards are permitted and must be displayed in AiA-provided sleeve.

Artists who do not present with the correct bin will not be permitted to participate in the Market section.

## **MAXIMUM SIZE – 2D SMALL WORKS**

Width: 24 inches

Height: 24 inches

Depth: Up to 1 inch thick (canvas or cradle)

---

## **WRAPPING & PACKAGING REQUIREMENTS**

- All pieces must be enclosed in **Krystal Seal Archival Art & Photo Bags** (or equivalent archival packaging).
  - White foam board or mat board backing is required.
  - Backing must not extend beyond the artwork dimensions.

- Backing must not exceed the 24” maximum size.
- **NO cardboard or poster board permitted for backing.**

## **MATERIAL-SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS**

Small Wrapped Canvas:  
Must include white foam core or mat board backing.

Plein Air Panels:  
Hard white canvas panels do not require foam core or mat board backing.

Paper Artwork:  
Must be matted and have white foam core or mat board cut to fit the edge of artwork.  
A one-inch foam core border is acceptable.

Photos and Prints:  
Must have white foam core or mat board cut to the edge of artwork.  
A one-inch foam core border is acceptable.

## **3D SMALL WORKS MARKET DETAILS**

(Separate JotForm registration provided to accepted artists.)

### **Guidelines**

- Not part of judging.
- All 3D small works must fit within a **24” x 24” footprint.**

## **2D and 3D INVENTORY REQUIREMENTS**

Inventory must be submitted via JotForm and include:

- Artist Name
  - Title
  - Price
  - Size

Inventory Deadline: **October 4, 2026**

## **LABELING REQUIREMENTS**

Each piece must be labeled on the **front upper right corner** for 2D and **under item** for 3D with:

- Artist Name
  - Title
  - Price
  - Size
  - Medium
- Clearly marked “ORIGINAL” or “REPRODUCTION”
