Open to all artists 18 years of age and older.
Artists may submit ORIGINAL two-dimensional (2-D) work
and three-dimensional (3-D) work.

ENTRY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All entries must be for sale.
- Commission pieces are not allowed.
- Art must remain in show until sold or designated time for pick-up.
- The artist must have sole ownership over the artwork.
- Artist or designee must deliver artwork to the Station No2 on designated date/time. Shipped art can be arranged by shipping Artwork to ARTnNCEvents at 1532 Eastbourne Dr. Wilmington, NC 28411. Artist must include return shipping slip with artwork. If painting is not sold it will be shipped back in the box it was delivered in.
- The Carolina Art Show allows photographs to be taken during the event.
- The Juror’s decision on acceptance is final.
- The Carolina Arts show along with ARTnNCEvents maintains the rights to use photographs of the art and the event for marketing or promotional materials.
- Artwork will be used on Social Media to promote the show and the artists.
- Make sure you correctly fill out the application as that information will be used in the show.
- Prices are not allowed to be changed once submitted to the show. Please fill out our Applications correctly.

- **If Artwork is sold after being accepted and prior to the start of the Carolina Art Show the artists agrees to the terms of the show and contract where the painting must still be displayed in said show and the commission is still owed to the Carolina Art Show.**
- Upon entering the show and by submitting payment, the artist agrees to the terms and conditions as outlined in this Prospectus.

EXHIBITED ARTWORK ELIGIBILITY

- Artwork must be solely the creation of the artist.
- Artwork must be original in conception, composition and implementation.
- No kits, copies, collaborative works or workshop pieces will be accepted.
- No replicas, giclee reproductions or any modified, copied or imitated art will be accepted.
- The quality of the creation and design should be consistent with a fine art show.
- No erotic or violent themes will be accepted.
- Photography, lithographs, woodcut prints, are accepted but it must be from a limited print or 1/1 special edition. **No open or mass printed items.**
- Artwork requiring individual easels will not be accepted.
- Weight of 2D art must not exceed 15lbs because of the hanging systems.
- 2D artwork must be ready for hanging on the display panels. This means it should be wire with D-rings and ready to hang.
- All artwork must be durable enough to be handled and moved.
- 2D artwork is artwork which can be hung on exhibit panels. 3D artwork is artwork which is to be displayed on a table or display column.
- Painting must be gallery wrapped, 1.5 panel or framed.
- **$\frac{3}{4}$ canvas that is NOT framed will not be displayed in the show.** – Please read.
- Please No wet paintings or incomplete work, it will be not accepted.

RULES

- Artists cannot hang, place or move any artwork. Carolina Art Show team will do this on your behalf with the utmost care and professionalism.
- Artwork that does not meet the criteria outlined herein or that is not ready for display will be refused/removed/returned.
- Work that does not meet criteria can be refused on the day of check-in. The Carolina Art Show and affiliates reserve the right to refuse artwork entries and cannot be held liable for any damage or loss.
- Artists must abide by the Prospectus, rules, entry terms and conditions and all other guidelines.
- **In the event of the sale of a piece within two weeks of the Carolina Art Show that results from exposure at the Show, a 35% commission is due to the Carolina Art Show/Bradley Carter Art LLC.**

- After registering art, if art sells prior to the show start date, the piece is committed to hanging as SOLD and will be subject to a 35% commission.
- When submitting your application to said show, please fill out all information correctly as this information will be used for advertising, showcards, etc.

SALES

- The artist is committed to the sale price(s) listed upon registration.
- A 35% commission will be taken on all sales.
- Sales tax will be paid by Carolina Art Show (ARTnNCEvents & Bradley Carter Art LLC)
- Artists will have the option if accepted into the show to be represented post show for 30 days where ARTnNCEvents and the Carolina Art Show will continue to promote your work. If a sale is made in that 30 day window the same rules and commission will apply to that sale.

WHAT TO KNOW FOR ALL 2D ARTWORK

Mediums	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acrylic, Alcohol ink, Collage, Digital Art, Drawing, Egg Tempera, Encaustic, Stained Glass, Gouache, Metal, Mixed Media, Oil, Pastel, Printmaking, Textile, Watercolor, Other. • Traditional Fine Art Photography, Digital Conceptualization Photography. Note: Photography must be original and limited series - Traditional paper and metal are accepted. • No giclees, prints or reproductions. 		
Size Limitations-Not Including Frame	Width 40 inches	Height 40 inches	
Size Limitations to Outside Edge of Frame	Width 42 inches	Height 42 inches	
Diptych or Triptych	Must be connected and not exceed the 42 inches overall size limit		
Weight	15lb maximum including frame		

Plexiglass	Any piece over 30 inches that requires glass, such as pastel or watercolor, must use plexiglass. Anything under 30" can still use glass.
Professional Presentation	Quality framed or 1.5 inch gallery wrapped canvas or 1.5 inch cradle is accepted. 3/4 inch canvas must be framed.
Mats	White, black, off white, or light neutral mats only. A thin color liner is acceptable.
Hanging	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2D art will be hung on one or two pin hooks, depending on size and weight of art, on ARTnNCEvents carpeted Pro-Panel display systems. • Picture hanging wires must be slack enough for someone to reach behind the art and place the wire on the small hook(s). Be sure the wire does not allow the artwork to lean outward, nor should the wire be visible above the picture after it is hung. • Make sure the wire is of adequate strength to support the painting. No sawtooth hangers. • In summary, the artwork must be securely wired and professionally mounted. Enough slack must be left in the wire, so the piece can be easily hung.
Identification	Each piece must have a label with artist's name, title of artwork, medium, price and size affixed to the <u>back</u> upper right corner.

WHAT TO KNOW FOR ALL 3D ARTWORK

3D ARTWORK DETAILS	
Exhibited Pieces	2 Maximum
Mediums	Ceramic, Glass, Metal, Mixed Media, Paper, Plastic, Textile, Wood, Jewelry, Other
Size Limitations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All artwork must be able to be displayed on a pedestal. It cannot exceed 18" in diameter. • Sculptures of five feet or taller that stand safely on the floor and do not exceed the weight limit will be considered.
Maximum weight	30 lbs.
Professional Presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Top heavy or unstable work will not be accepted. • 3D work with a top or lid or separate piece(s) must have the separate pieces secured and labeled. • Freestanding sculptures requiring special mounting or suspension will not be accepted. • No illuminated pieces that require electrical connections will be accepted.
Identification	Each piece must have a label with artist's name, title of artwork, medium, and price affixed to the bottom.
